AWARDS AND CRITERIA

HONOR-VALOR AWARD:

Awarded for an act or deed of personal bravery of self-sacrifice, involving risk to the individual's own life, above and beyond the performance of duty.

MERITORIOUS AWARD:

Awarded for service rendered when an individual, with diligence and perseverance, conspicuously performs their duty. Examples: prevents crime, protects life and/or property, apprehends criminals, or otherwise performs a deed which reflects credit upon the individual and the agency he or she represents.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD:

Awarded to an individual that has dedicated years of unqualified giving and service to the betterment of their community, department/unit, and profession and through his/her efforts has inspired and served as a leader to other public safety service professionals.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

Burlington County police officers, County detectives, troopers, firefighters, or emergency squad members or their family members will be eligible for these monetary awards. **This year, the Club will award a total of three (3) scholarships.** Three (3) general scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$2,500 each. One (1) \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded and dedicated in the name of Retired Superintendent of the New Jersey State Police, Eugene Olaff. As many as three (3) awards can be made, based upon a combination of need, application review, and a short essay by the applicant on the importance and meaning of public safety service to the community.

ADVANCED TRAINING AWARD:

Awarded for advanced public safety training programs which enhance the individual's ability to perform their duties or conduct the training necessary to improve other members' capabilities.

MUST BE:

1. **An active Burlington County Police Officer, County Detective, State Trooper (stationed in Burlington County), Firefighter, or Emergency Squad Member of an immediate family member of an active Burlington County Police Officer, County Detective, State Trooper (stationed in Burlington County), Firefighter, or Emergency Squad Member (the applicant must specify with this application who the immediate family member is and which department, agency or squad the immediate family member is employed or affiliated with). Please note that the entire application must be completed**

AND

2. **Submit an essay of no more than 500 words concerning the following topic: **In light of the fiscal crisis that many of New Jersey’s municipalities have experienced and the added pressure from the New Jersey Governor’s Office and the Legislature to trim back spending on public employee costs, what is the future of public safety in New Jersey? Will the state and local governments who implement our public safety network be able to continue to provide for our citizens needs? Would you personally consider a career in the public sector public safety field?****

ADVANCED TRAINING AWARD APPLICATION CRITERIA

ELIGIBILITY:

1. For your department, squad or unit to be eligible to receive an Advanced Training Scholarship Award, you must return to the 200 Club a thorough description of the program, seminar or course of training that you are requesting the 200 Club to consider for scholarship purposes. Your description of the program should include but not limited to the full name of the course, seminar or instructional training program, name of the instructor or school, some form of application or informational sheet which describes the training program or seminar, the cost of the training program or seminar and a description of the individuals who you wish to send to this training program or seminar.
2. Submittal to the 200 Club should also describe in depth why you are requesting this monetary scholarship assistance and most importantly, how you feel the Advanced Training Program or Seminar will impact and assist the residents of your community.
3. Please note that the 200 Club has up to \$3,000 available this year for Advanced Training Scholarships. The Club will only pay to any one department, unit, or squad in Burlington County up to \$1,000.
